We are looking for dedicated individuals to join the sound booth. No prior experience is required! We provide full, hands-on training. See the sign-up sheet in the fellowship hall.

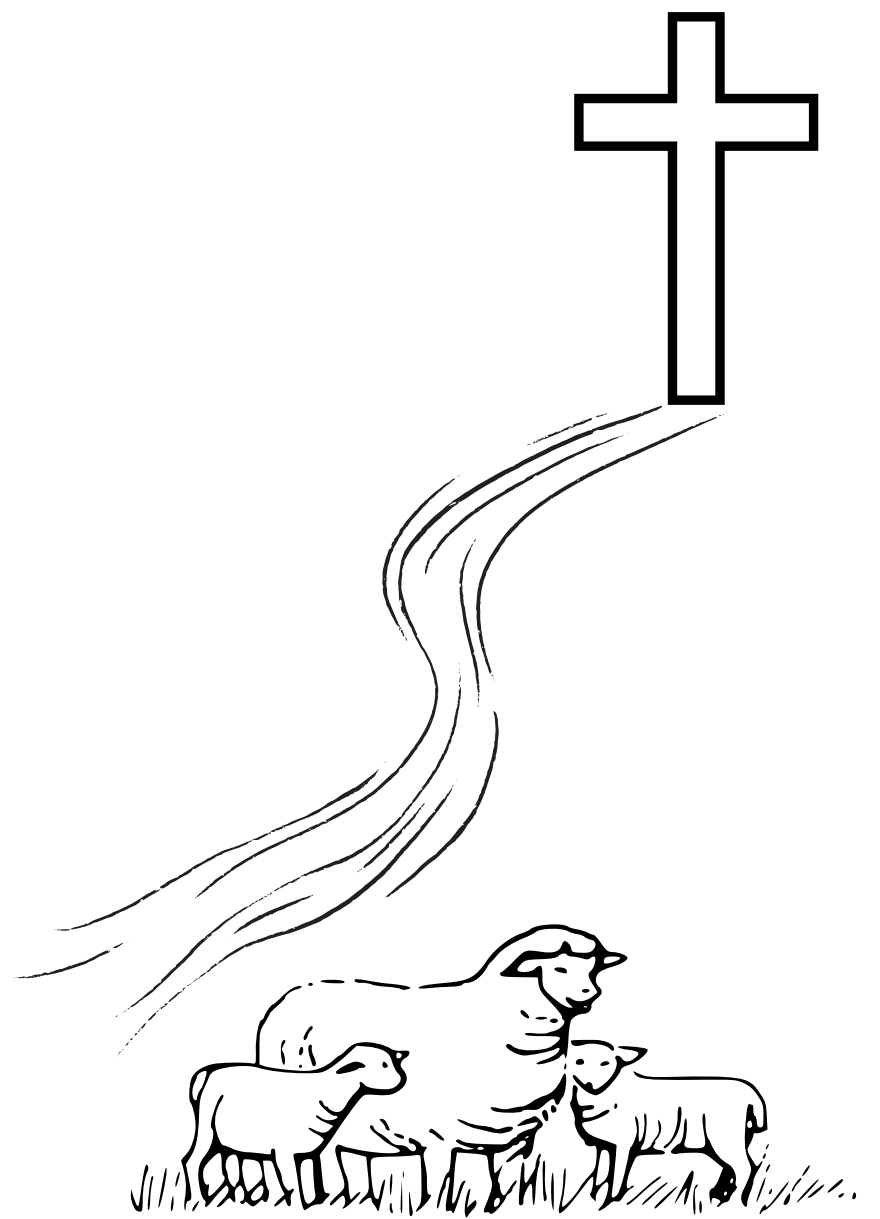
