February is Bethel's month to deliver Meals on Wheels.

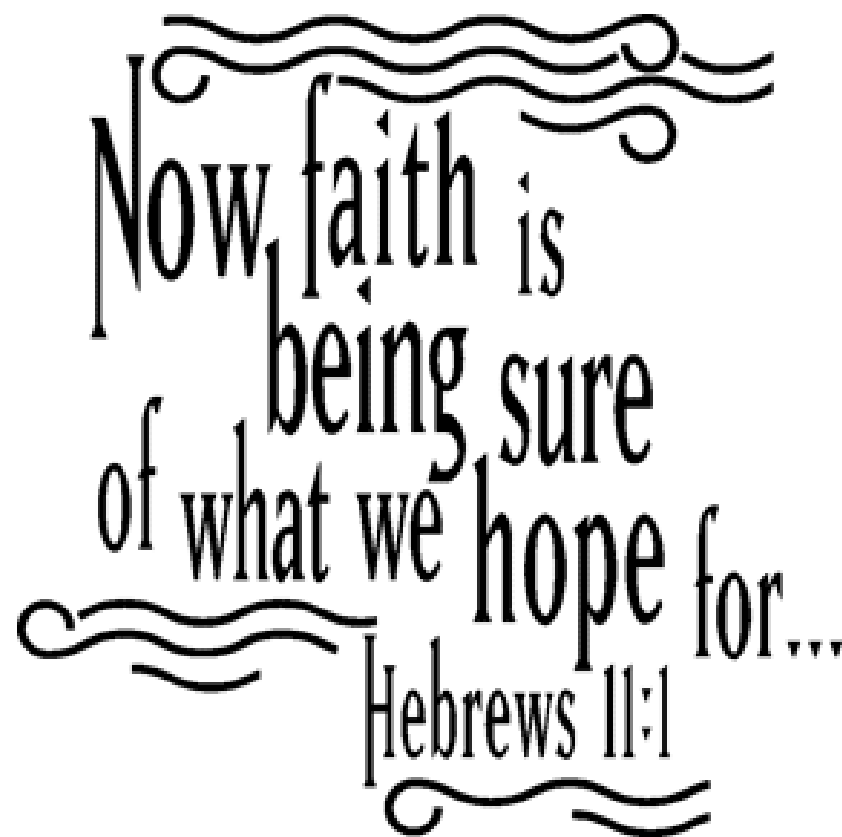
