Prompt: Jesus lived a human life for over 30 years before dying on the cross. What does His human life tell us about God?

Prompt: What does it say about Jesus that He willingly gave up His life for you? What does it say about you?

Prompt: Why did the sacrifice for all of our sins have to be Jesus, and not someone/something else?

Readings: Philippians 3:12-21, 1 Thessalonians 4:13-5-11

Prompt: How does the Resurrection of Christ impact not just our futures, but our everyday lives?

Prompt: How does confessing Jesus as Lord give our lives purpose and meaning?

Prompt: Jesus' followers were often called "witnesses" after His resurrection, but that word also means "martyrs." How does that shape our understanding of the Christian life?

Prompt: Why do we call Jesus our Prophet?

Readings: Hebrews 7, 1 John 2:1-17

Prompt: Why do we call Jesus our Priest?

Readings: John 18:33-19:16, Ephesians 1:15-23

Prompt: Why do we call Jesus our King?

Readings: Numbers 11:16-30, Joel 2:18-32

Prompt: Why would Moses wish for all people to have God's Spirit?

Prompt: The apostles were frequently threatened, tortured, or killed during their ministry. What does their response tell us about the Christian life?

Thu, May 25

Readings: Acts 9:1-31, Ephesians 3:1-13

Prompt: Why would Jesus choose someone like Saul (Paul) to serve as an apostle?

Fri, May 26

Readings: Acts 8:26-40, Acts 10:34-11:18, 2 Timothy 4:1-5
