C: We sing praises to God for the salvation Christ brings to us!


P: Because of Christ, the weak are strengthened, the fearful are encouraged, and the unrighteous are redeemed!


C: God has come to us in Christ to walk with us in the paths of righteousness, so we come to praise and worship our Lord and Savior.




Prayer of Confession


Luke 21:25-36

For the powers of the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. Now when these things begin to take place, straighten up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."

who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets.


And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church, I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins,






