GENERAL GUIDELINES

- We ask that your family conduct a home health screening before attending programs here at Averboro. This is to ensure everyone is well before arriving on campus.
- **Check-In will be located at the Carport Door Entrance.** We ask that ALL families with children please park near the carport door and enter here, regardless of what service you attend.
- The carport will not be available to drive-thru. Please park and walk your family to the door.
- We will create and publish a "What to Expect" video to give families a look at all the measures we are taking to ensure a safe experience.

MASKS

- Anyone 6 years and older will be asked to wear a mask the entire time they are in our building.
- Preschoolers under 6 years old are not required to wear one, but parents are welcome to send their child wearing a mask if you would like for your child to have one.

VOLUNTEERS

- Volunteers will be required to wear a mask but will be offered a single-use one if they would like.
- All volunteers will be asked screening questions, and temperature checked. They will only be permitted to serve if their temperature is below 100 degrees Fahrenheit.

CHECK-IN

- Families will be asked only to have one adult enter the Averboro Kids area for drop off and pick up. The same parent will drop off and pick up from the classrooms. Other family members may enter the "Steps" door.
- An Averboro KIDS Volunteer will operate all Check-In stations, and parents will receive their child's name tag and security badge. Babies-Twos will also receive a pager.
- We will ask all people who enter the building to put on Hand sanitizer at the check-in station.
- Screening Questions and Temperatures of all people entering the Averboro KIDS environment will be taken, including volunteers. Only those with temperatures below 100 degrees Fahrenheit will be allowed to enter the Averboro KIDS environment. If a parent, child, or volunteer has a temperature above 100 degrees Fahrenheit, they will be invited to watch online. This includes children who have a parent with a temperature above 100 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Once families have checked-in, parents will drop their children off at their classrooms. Look for the signs because classrooms may have changed.

PICK-UP

- The same parent who dropped off their children will pick up their children at the classroom door.
- Parents must present the security badge they received at Check-In to their child's teacher for pickup.
- Please be mindful of other families and keep socially distant apart when waiting in the hallway.
- Once you have picked up your child, you may exit the Steps or Carport door. Please see an Aversboro KIDS Volunteer for guidance as this may change if other kids are arriving.

CLASSROOMS

- Each classroom will be at a limited occupancy, and we will keep classes small to fit the room's size.
- Only volunteers and kids will be allowed to enter the classrooms. Parents, please stay in the hallway when dropping off or picking up your child off.
- Outside toys and snacks will temporarily not be permitted in the classrooms.
- Hand sanitizer and gloves will be available in all classrooms.
- All Classroom surfaces and toys will be cleaned/disinfected between programs.
 - Cleaning checklist includes: toys, surfaces, diaper changing areas, door handles, bathrooms, and furniture.
- Each classroom will also receive a "fog" cleaning regularly by our cleaning staff.
- Staff & Volunteers will follow the cleaning procedures and guidelines found in
