Aversboro Road Baptist Church Virtual Learning Care for Elementary and Middle School Students

COVID-19 Policy

We are providing this ministry as a resource to help working parents with care for their child due to virtual learning with COVID-19. Virtual Learning Care will allow students to learn and grow when they are not physically in school. An option of this nature will help support working parents of our church by providing the structure and support needed when a teacher or parent cannot.

Due to the contagious nature of COVID-19 in our area, AVERSBORO ROAD BAPTIST CHURCH will implement policies to protect all program participants, staff, and families.

- 1. <u>Face Masks.</u> Face masks are to be worn at all times for anyone five years of age and older. The face mask must cover both the nose and mouth. All students and staff will be required to provide their face mask, and the mask must be securely in place before entering our building.
- 2. <u>Temperature Checks.</u> Each student and staff member will have their temperature checked upon arrival each day. In the event, any individual has a temperature of 100° or higher, that individual (and any other participants within the same household) will not be permitted to enter the facility until they provide documentation of a negative COVID test. Temperature checks may also be completed at random during the day.
- 3. <u>Hand Sanitizer</u>. Each student and staff member will use hand sanitizer before entering the facility and will cooperate to use hand sanitizer throughout the day when necessary to maintain cleanliness throughout the facility.
- 4. <u>Travel</u>. No student or staff will be permitted entry if they have traveled out of the country or on an airplane in the past 14 days.
- 5. <u>Symptoms.</u> No student or staff member may participate if they are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19. Symptoms may include cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, chills, fever, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headaches, sore throat, the new loss of taste or smell.
- 6. Exposure. No student or staff member will be permitted entrance into the facility if they have been around anyone infected by COVID-19 or with the symptoms listed above in the past 14 days. In the event a student or staff member is exposed to COVID-19, they will be required to provide a signed, written statement that they have been quarantined for 14 days and provide documentation of a negative COVID test before returning to the program.

In the event a student or staff member fails to comply with the policies written above, AVERSBORO ROAD BAPTIST CHURCH explicitly reserves the right to restrict the student from participation in the virtual learning program at Aversboro Road Baptist Church.
