BIBLE READINGS FOR THIS WEEK : 1 Cor 9:1 – 1 Cor 16:24

HYMN OF THE DAY: *"Let Us Ever Walk with Jesus,"* is a hymn that encapsulates this process of learning to rise. Just as a seed is sown to rise again, and as a branch leaf's out from its root, we too follow Jesus' leading, "full of faith and hope and love." As we sing, we are reminded that discipleship is not a moment but a journey. Christ walks with us in sorrow and in joy, in trial and in peace, forming in us the lasting gifts that remain. May our worship today strengthen our faith, steady our hope, and deepen our love as we walk with Him

A WORD: *1 Corinthians 13:13* Paul tells us that *"these three remain: faith, hope, and love. But the greatest of these is love.* This verse tells us to follow Christ in a way that forms these virtues within us. To walk with Jesus is an act of **faith**—trusting His leading even when the path is steep. It is sustained by **hope**—believing His promises, His presence, and His victory over sin and death. And it is shaped by **love**—the love Christ shows us and the love He teaches us to extend to others.

ABOUT THE BULLETIN COVER: Jesus was heading to Jerusalem, where He would suffer, be killed, and rise again. Peter attempted to lead Him in another direction, but Jesus directed him and the other disciples to follow Him and take up their own crosses. However, the cross of Jesus was His alone to bear in order to bring us forgiveness. We follow Him by the gift of faith. Following Jesus means dying to ourselves, confessing our sins, and trusting that death in Him means resurrection life.
