

Who Is Jesus?

The Militant Christ

Revelation 19:11-21

1. The most prominent attribute of Jesus in Revelation 19 is that He “makes war.” Revelation 19:11
 - A. Revelation 19:11-16 is primarily a description of Jesus.
 - B. Revelation 19:17-21 describes the war between Jesus and the forces of evil.

2. There are at least fifteen attributes of Jesus found in Revelation 19:11-16.
 - A. Jesus is... riding a white horse, “Faithful,” “True,” a righteous judge, righteous in waging war.
Revelation 19:11 (five attributes)
 - B. Jesus has... “eyes are like a flame of fire,” “many diadems [crowns],” a name that is beyond our understanding or comprehension.
Revelation 19:12 (three attributes)
 - C. Jesus has a robe dipped in blood. [See also Isaiah 63:1-6]
Jesus is called “The Word of God.” [See also John 1:1-3]
Revelation 19:13 (two attributes)
 - D. Jesus leads an army. Revelation 19:14 (one attribute)
 - E. Jesus will... “strike down the nations,” rule the nations “with a rod of iron,”
“tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty [carry out the wrath of God on the nations for the evil that they have done.] Revelation 19:15 (three attributes)
 - F. Jesus is “King of Kings and Lord of Lords.” Revelation 19:16 (one attribute)

3. Against whom is Jesus waging war?
 - A. The unholy trinity of evil. Revelation 16:13-14, Revelation 19:19-20
 - B. The kings of the earth and their armies. Revelation 19:19

4. How can the Prince of Peace [Isaiah 9:6] wage war?
 - A. He is a righteous judge. Revelation 19:11
 - B. He is not the initiator of the war. Revelation 17:12-14
 - C. In truth, how can the Prince of Peace not wage war? [He is the instrument of God’s wrath that is poured out on the nations. Revelation 19:15]

5. What are some lessons for us today from Revelation 19:11-21?
 - A. Jesus is the one to bring God’s vengeance, not us. Romans 12:17-21
 - B. Know of God’s heart of love for the wicked and hear His call to repent. Ezekiel 33:11
 - C. Have hope! One day all war will end.
 - D. Rejoice! One day Jesus will defeat evil and establish a Kingdom of justice and peace.
