## Miracle - A Pointer to God Acts 9:32-43

**Introduction:** The emerging gospel church spread to Gentile lands through a dramatically converted Jewish Pharisee Saul. Back then to Judea at the same period, Peter brought the show of Gospel power to change many lives.

## I. Aneas miraculously healed. vss. 32-35

Similar to the healing of the paralytic by Jesus Mark 2:11

vs. 34 "Rise up" lit. "Make a seat at the table to go on eating."

## II. Tabitha / Dorcas miraculously healed—raised from death vss. 36-43

Similar to healing of synagogue official's daughter. Mark 5:40-42

Parallels to Lazarus' healing John 11

The spectacle drew many to hear and respond to the God of wonders

**Summary:** Miracle of healing/death to life; acts of God mediated thru man These are pointers to:

- Character of God, Christ is Lord/Messiah, set up kingdom over death
- Call for salvation/redemption- to all who will bow to this mighty God

## III. Miracles - we see here, two main types of miracles found in the Bible

- 1. Reversal of physical disability
- 2. Bringing back to life from death

**Definition:** An <u>extraordinary</u>/unexplainable, <u>visible</u>, <u>redemptive</u> event ordained by God, arousing <u>awe & worship</u>, to <u>reveal God</u> in His saving purposes for mankind. (commentator Gordon Keddie, John Frame)

**Application:** God uses His people who are not perfect examples of grace, to declare the perfect Savior of grace to sinners. As God used Peter, so God uses you!

Mark 1:17 Luke 5:3-10

1 Peter 2:4-6, 9-10

Although we many not feel able to speak, so God shows that He is able!

Even in your own failures and sin, do you trust Christ to help you overcome? **Jesus said**, "I am the resurrection & the life. He who believes in me will live, even if he dies." John 11:25 Aeneas & Tabitha are w/ Him now, will you be?
