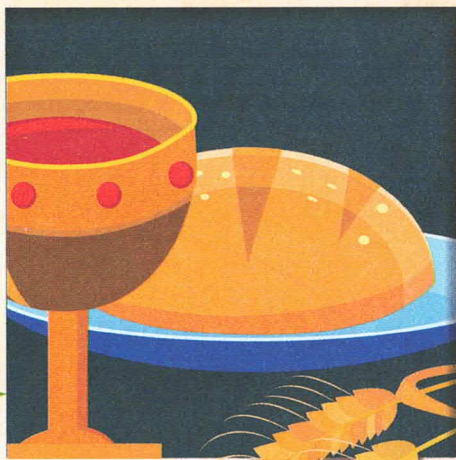

Mike Meester: went in for ablation to correct AFib; then moved to ICU due to low blood pressure & renal decline. Starting to improve & hoping to return home early this week.

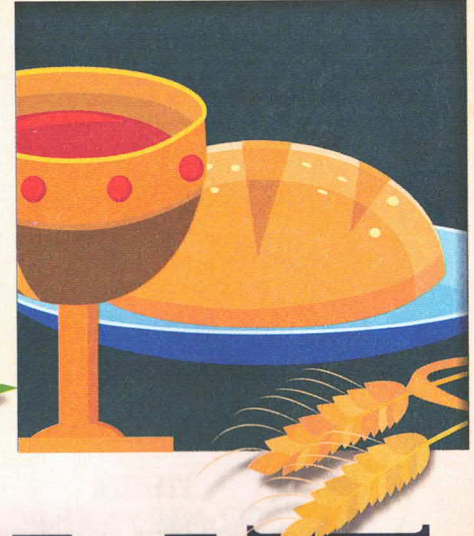
Clarence Murra (Randy's father): Had a stroke last Tuesday. Currently at Allen Hospital. Further care to be determined.
