Weekly Prayer


Every Wednesday

2026 Book Club Pick: "My Dear Hemlock"

Meeting Sunday, February 1st @3pm

A book for every Christian woman: This spiritual novel is presented in an allegorical, fictional tale, a darkly witty tale of feminine temptation and subtle sabotage. This captivating read is designed specifically for the Christian woman seeking inspiration, growth, and a deeper understanding of her faith. What lies within this Christian novel is a series of letters between the cunning Madame Hoaxrot and her junior devil, Hemlock, as they hatch diabolical plans to undermine a young woman's spiritual journey. Their goal? To corrupt every aspect of her life—from her relationships and friendships to her self-perception, empathy, and even motherhood. Unique among Christian fiction books for women, this book offers profound insights and reflections that resonate

with the everyday experiences of women. My Dear Hemlock offers an eye-opening exploration of the struggles women face through the lens of these manipulative forces, shedding light on how virtues can mask hidden vices. Ladies, our Christian book by author Tilly Dillehay will provide you with a sharpened awareness of the pitfalls that lie in wait behind the veil of feminine virtues. Portraying a theme similar to the Screwtape Letters by C.S Lewis, it speaks to all Christian women who desire to grow in their faith and understanding. 
