



2026 Book Club Pick: “My Dear Hemlock”

Unique among Christian fiction books for women, this book offers profound insights and reflections that resonate with the everyday experiences of women. My Dear Hemlock offers an eye-opening exploration of the struggles women face through the lens of these manipulative forces, shedding light on how virtues can mask hidden vices. Ladies, our Christian book by author Tilly Dillehay will provide you with a sharpened awareness of the pitfalls that lie in wait behind the veil of feminine virtues. Portraying a theme similar to the Screwtape Letters by C.S Lewis, it speaks to all Christian women who desire to grow in their faith and


MISSION
