Love One Another week 2
1 John 4-5

1. How can we balance the instruction to "test the spirits" with the commandment to love all?
2. What does "perfect love" look like in your life, and how can you strive to embody it more fully?
3. How does acknowledging that "Jesus Christ has come in the flesh" shape our understanding of God and His love for us?
4. If 1 John 4:18 states "perfect love drives out fear," why do many believers still struggle with fear despite their faith?
5. How does the connection between love and obedience depicted in verses 1-3 reflect in your life?
6. Does 1 John 5:4's claim that "everyone born of God overcomes the world" contradict observable reality of suffering among believers?
7. How can we discern the will of God when making requests in prayer?

Application: What are some practical ways to reject worldly Love? How can this relate to sharing God's love with someone who's never trusted in Jesus, yet?
