My Trinity Family,

Spring-time is upon us! The sun is staying out a little longer every day. The temperatures are warming up. Fields are being planted. Maybe you've even been digging around in your own flowerbeds and gardens.

Jesus used the idea of planting a kermel of wheat to describe what a human life is like that is either buried with him or setting its own course. While the actual understanding and living of this is super complex, the picture is pretty simple: the human heart that seeks to control its own destiny is like a seed that is never planted; but the human heart that seeks to control its own destiny is like a seed that is never planted; but the human heart in the hand of God, that is buried to its own control, will actually "die" to that old way of life that doesn't produce anything, and instead will grow into a vibrant plant that actually produces many seeds - that is, more kingdom-of-God-stuff in the world!

My sweet friends, it is very easy to end up living the "single-seed non-life." We can get in routines and they turn into ruts that actually keep our hearts far from God, even as we go through the very motions of singing hymns and songs, praying prayers, serving in God's house, and participating in worship.

I want to invite you to let Jesus plant you this Spring. What do I mean by that?

Would you be willing to consider one way in which God could have a little more access to your real heart? Maybe you decide to commit to praying one honest prayer every week to Jesus (something like, "Jesus, will you helpme want to notice my heart and share it with you.") Maybe you decide to commit to coming to the Discipleship Hour at 9am for six weeks. Maybe you decide to intentionally try to get to know one person at church better and to share more of your own story with them. It could be anything! But the invitation is to let a little more of your real heart be open to God because the seed of your heart planted by God will not only die (to the single-seed non-life), but it will grow and flourish and produce vibrant life.

So...what do you say? I want to let Jesus have a little more access and plant you?
