# Martin Luther developed beliefs that later became known as Lutheranism. 1517, Luther publicly criticized the selling of indulgences by the Pope and Johann Tetzel (a fellow monk). Indulgences: Pay \$ to be forgiven of sins. Luther posted his 95 theses (or statements) about indulgences on a church door. Because Luther had challenged church practices he was denounced by church leaders. By 1520 Luther openly disagreed with many other church doctrines.
