The Ripple Effect of One Kind Act

My mom's name is Karen, and she is Chinese from Taiwan. She and Dad met in the Peace Corps in the '70s in Malaysia where he taught her English. They fell in love and moved to Wisconsin, where he earned his PhD.

When I was about ten years old, Mom took my sisters and me to an Asian grocery store to buy some food you can't find at other stores. We waited in the car and, the next thing we knew, my mom came back with a tall Asian man named Yu. She had just met him in the checkout line and was giving him a ride home. Mom often did things like this, bringing food and visiting shut-ins, helping families navigate the cultural differences here in America.

We visited Yu in his student apartment and also met his wife. Mom spoke Chinese, but neither of them spoke much English, so there was a lot of head-nodding and smiling. Yu was a music student at the University of Wisconsin who had moved from China to get a degree and build a better life. Yu and Mom stayed in touch even after he and his wife moved to Florida to continue his studies.

One night, Yu called my mom in a panic. His wife was pregnant, they were certain they couldn't afford a child and they were considering an abortion. Mom talked Yu and his wife through that scary situation. She told them about God's love and plan for their baby, urging them not to have an abortion and connecting them with a Pro-Life group in their area. Yu and his wife listened to my mom and welcomed a baby boy into the world.

Recently, Mom showed me a picture of this beautiful family at their son's college graduation. It is an amazing story of God's work that began with my mom's act of kindness, giving a ride to a stranger in need.

This true story, written by a woman named Sarah, was related in a newspaper column and illustrates that, when we befriend and extend kindness to others, they will seek our counsel in moments of need. "Be ye kind one to another" (Ephesians 4:32).
