**BELMONT BAPTIST CHURCH** - On November 13, 1924, Belmont Heights Baptist Church was born and was comprised of 38 charter members who met under the oak trees at the corner of 32<sup>nd</sup> and Wilder. Several different buildings were erected and much remodeling occurred on that property and the church grew. In 1966, the church purchased 7 acres in the 7800 block of North 56<sup>th</sup> St and Belmont Baptist Church was born. Belmont Heights/Belmont has had 16 pastors and has sent out 9 ordained pastors. Belmont has supported 9 mission churches in the Tampa area . We currently support a Christian church and school in Sierra Leone, Africa, and they are flourishing. We have partnered here with Paideia Classical Christian School since 2006; they share our property and train up Christian youth. God has also sent us Hill City Church to share our space and to influence us with their enthusiasm and passion for the Lord's work. Though here for only a year, they have inspired us all to continue to Build God's Kingdom Together. Soon after Hill City joined us, the Tampa United Korean School began to teach its 54 students on Saturday, here at Belmont. We are truly blessed. God continues to provide for us. Be encouraged. He is not done with us yet.

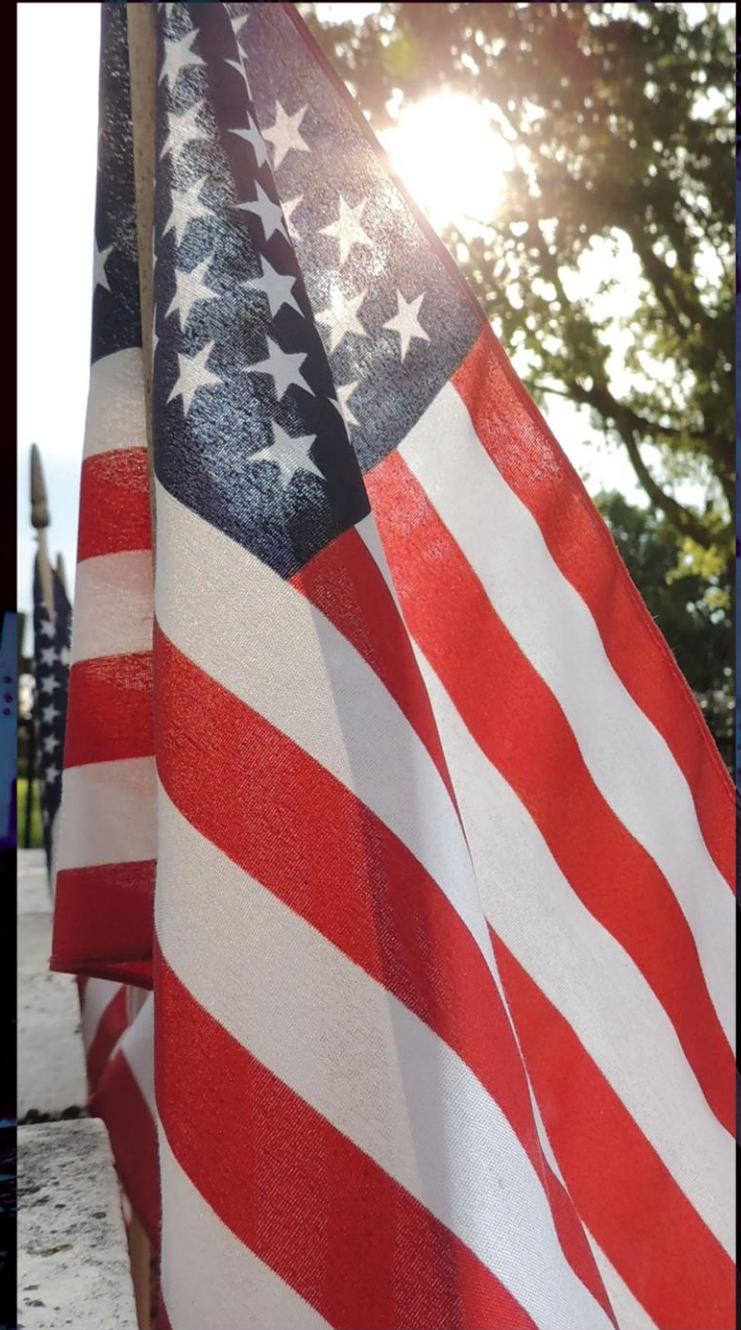
