Dear Church Family,

As events continue to unfold in our community and country, and seeking to be wise in our response, we have altered our original course of action for the next several weeks, given updated information and recommendations from the CDC, MN Dept of Health and Todd County Health and Human Services.

For the next 4 weeks, our Sunday morning service is cancelled (March 22, 29, April 5 & 12) in addition to suspending other activities held in our church building (Sunday School, Ignite, Crossfire, Quest Kids, and all other meetings & events) until at least April 13 (Monday), the day after Easter Sunday. This means that, at this time, we will not be having an Easter service or breakfast. However, starting this Sunday, a recorded version of Pastor Matt's weekly message will be available to view via the church website: [fbclongprairie.org](http://fbclongprairie.org). Starting next Sunday, March 29, we are hoping to offer a live streaming worship service that includes both music and the morning message at 10:15am. More information will follow once details are confirmed.

For those wanting to continue to give tithes and offerings during these next 4 weeks, you may do so online (via the website), by mail, or by dropping your gift off at the church office window with Jenni during regular office hours (Mon-Thu 8am-3pm).

Our concern for our church family and community is to do our part at this critical time to minimize exposure to COVID-19, to help "flatten the curve" of people needing medical care in our community. We are thankful that as of today the number of reported cases in Todd County remains at zero. But we know that will likely change. Thank you for understanding and prayer for our church family and community, praising God that He continues to remain sovereign and in control of our world and uncertain times.
