This summer, I will be conducting a 22-mile road march to help raise awareness for those veterans suffering from PTSD and to honor and bring awareness for those who have lost to the battle within. Being a suicide survivor and having lost brothers of my own, this mission is personal to me. The 22 miles will launch from the Scioto Audobon Park and take us north along the Scioto and Olentangy Rivers along the scenic Olentangy River Trail. The turnaround point will be on the Olentangy River Trail, parallel to the Graceland shopping center which is approximately 11 miles north of Scioto Audobon Park. Each mile of this walk will be dedicated to a Soldier, Sailor, Airman, Marine or Coast Guardsman that has lost the battle to their own demons. If you are in the area, I encourage you to join me.
