

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE | Genesis 24:34,37-38,42-46,48,5-61,63-67

SESSION SUMMARY

In this session, we follow Abraham's servant on a quest to find a wife for Isaac and meet Rebekah—an answer to a very specific prayer. Through this story, we learn that because God always provides, we can confidently follow Him anywhere.

- · We can be confident in God's provision.
- · We can confidently go where God leads.

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- What does the servant's very specific prayer teach our family about the ways we can ask God for guidance?
- How have answered prayers in the past helped us believe God will answer prayers in the future? What are some effects this has on our family's prayer life?
- When has our family acted on what we believed about God? When have we not acted based on what we know to be true about God? Describe what happened in both scenarios.

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Invite everyone to share one important decision they need to make coming up. Spend time praying for each person to have very clear direction from God, just like the servant did in finding a wife for Isaac. Consider writing down your requests and recording specific ways they're answered over time.
