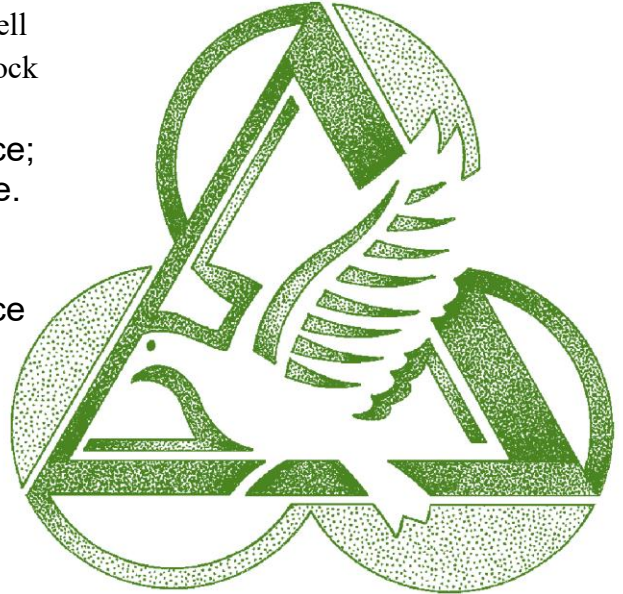
The sanctuary candles are lit

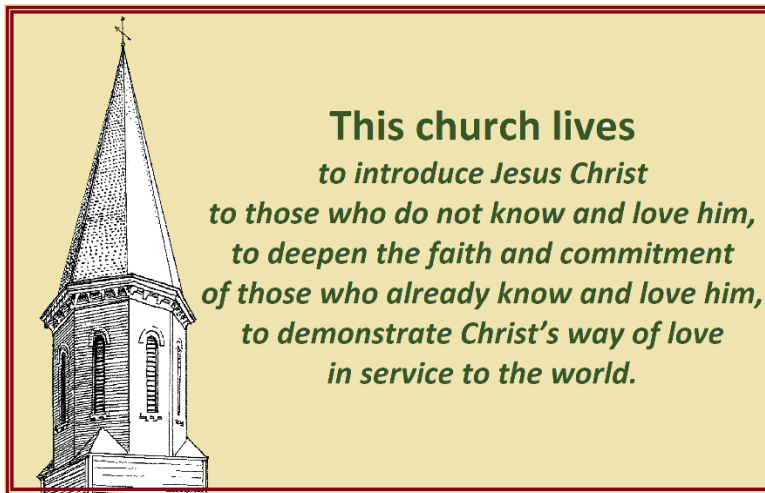
O Christ, the Way, the Truth, the Life, be with us now, we pray;
