Celebrating All Saints: November 2

November 1 is officially All Saints' Day, though we will celebrate the feast with communion on Sunday, November 2 during our morning worship service. Our worship will remind us of the communion we still keep with those now at rest in the Lord's presence, gathered in peace enjoying eternal communion with him. We will specifically remember those from our congregation who passed into glory over the past year.
