**6:15** - After the opening, the kids will split up into small groups and spend time in their handbook, reciting memory verses, answering questions, and learning about Jesus.


**6:50** - Game time! We will wear out your kiddos with exciting games so they will go right to sleep when they get home (no guarantees).

# Sign In and Sign Out Responsibilities

In order to ensure that your kiddos are always safe and accounted for, we ask that you follow our simple Sign-In and Sign-Out procedures:

- When you get to church, please bring your kiddos to the fellowship hall, the room directly across from the entrance.
- In the fellowship hall, an AWANA leader(s) will help you **Sign Them In** and make sure your kiddo(s) are ready for the evening.
- Each kiddo will receive a **NAME BADGE** that is theirs for the AWANA year. This will help us with check-in and check-out.
- When picking up your kiddo(s), please come back into the fellowship to **Sign Them Out**. Then listen to all the stories your kiddo will have from the evening!
- We ask that you come in each week to Sign your Kiddo(s) in and out. We will not release them until we see you. Thank you for your help with this.

AWANA offers a fun, proven approach for early evangelism and discipleship. Scripture-based programs and exciting games attract families, promote Bible literacy and help kids develop lifelong faith in Christ.

## Is there a Cost to AWANA?

Yes. But through the generous giving of members at Calvary Baptist Church this cost is covered so that every child can hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ and every parent can know that the Love of God extends beyond the walls of the building and into the hearts of each and every person that we get to share the gospel with, children and parents alike.





## **Can My Child Come To AWANA?**

If you have preschoolers (age 3 yrs.) to 6<sup>th</sup> graders, they are more than welcome to join us at AWANA! We want them to enjoy it so much that they will invite their friends to come!

We invite the parents to participate with their child(ren) from time to time, as this will encourage the family to grow together in their relationship with God.
