- 2. Each Lesson contains a Cover Sheet and Lesson Questions.
- 3. Each Lesson Question will show the Scripture to read in order to answer the question.
- 4. If you have a problem with a question you can either call your group leader or wait until your group discussion. <a href="Don't let it trouble you!">Don't let it trouble you!</a> It's a common part of any Bible Study. Remember each of us is at different levels in our understanding of the Bible. It's also possible something is wrong with the question. So if something isn't clear to you now be patient, because the more you study the more your understanding will grow.
