F.R.O.G. Ministry has been collecting new or "gently used" blankets. They will be giving these out to the homeless in Indianapolis.




F.R.O.G. Ministry greatly appreciates all of you who have donated blankets. If you brought a blanket today, please take it to the Welcome Center.
