"Beloved of God, called to be saints" - what a lovely thought! Beloved means to be deeply or cherished.
"called to be saints" - A saint in the Bible is not one who has attained to anything, but rather one who has been set apart by God asto Himself.
Our characteristic should be that WE ARE HIS!!!

Establishing believers involves:
Encouraging them by exhortation
Faith and faithfulness are vital factors in producing encouragement
This faith must be mutual, reciprocal in one another.
It was not enough for Paul to have faith, but they needed faith, and the interaction between their faith prompted
Paul goes onto say he is debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the wise, and to the unwise.
Greek
Barbarian - uncultured Wise
Unwise - uneducated
Paul was obligated to preach the gospel to!!!
To the extent of Paul's physical and mental ability, and as far as the circumstances surrounding him permitted, he was ready, prepared and to preach the gospel also to those in Rome.
