Did Paul want to come to Rome? (See Romans 1:10,13)

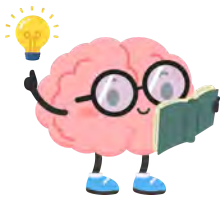
What reason did Paul give for not coming to them sooner?

What does the word “hindered” mean?

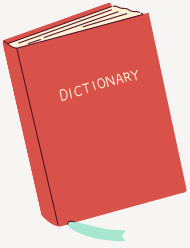
What are the first two words of verse 23?

What does Paul mean by saying “having no more place in these parts”?

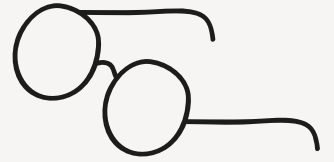
What was his great desire?

Read Romans 14:24 and 28. Where is Paul going to journey?

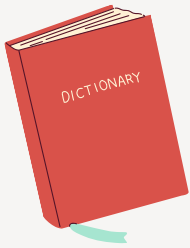
What does the word “trust” mean in this verse?

What is Paul saying when he says, “to be brought on my way thitherward by you”?

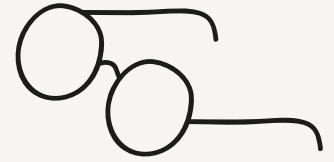
What does Paul say he first wants to do?

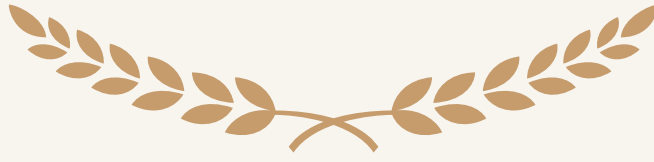
