The Summer months are upon us. This is a time when resources dwindle, and individual participation fluctuates weekly. Many have noted that presenting two separate Worship events at currently acceptable standards will be problematic during the summer months. Suggestions have come forward that it may be easier to combine resources for a time. I personally will not be present for worship on June 15, 22 & 29. Arrangements will be made for someone to fill the pulpit during my absence due to a family vacation.

The Worship Committee and Church Staff have had many conversations around maintaining a consistent quality for Sunday worship at a reasonable time for all involved. Without exception, a recommendation has come forward to offer summer hours during the months of June and July, with a return to our current offerings in August.

The Worship Committee and the Church Staff have thereby recommended we offer Sunday School at 9 am and a single combined Worship service at 10 am during June and July of 2025 and as Senior Pastor I concur with their decision. We will return to two services on August 3 and are planning a "Back to Church" Sunday on August 10 before Azle ISD classes begin on August 13.




