There is currently a desperate need for toiletries.

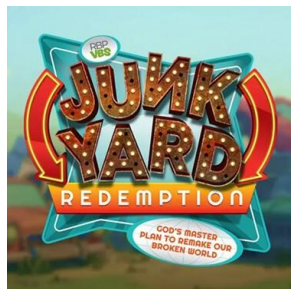

When I first joined Wycliffe back in 2005, the call was to use my IT hardware skills to support missions. That desire never went away, even though I was challenged and grew professionally in different assignments. WCA is growing and the need for a full-time tech support staff allows me to use these skills in a Christian school environment. As we reach the end of the 2026 Spring Semester, we sadly say "Goodbye" to several students who have become our friends. Last Friday, we celebrated 7 of our graduating students. When they reflected upon their experiences here at Penn State they each remembered meeting us shortly after arriving and recalled fond memories of our weekly dinners, Bible discussions, fun games and activities. Some expressed that our community is like their family. God has been working in their lives, showing them His love and grace as we read and studied the Gospel of John. For several, it was the first time to read the stories of Jesus and consider His teaching.

For those we met on a one-to-one basis, our spiritual conversations went deeper. Some expressed struggles in parent, friend, advisor and dating relationships. Others shared about their loneliness and feelings of isolation. Praying with and listening to these stressed and concerned students provided hope when they were weary.

Jack, from China, joined us for our Easter church service. He was struck by the joyful and meaningful lyrics of the songs and liked the Bible teaching. Jack has faithfully met with Jay for English partner lessons and spiritual discussions and joined us almost every Friday evening. Please pray for him to open his heart to Jesus and trust in Him with saving faith soon!

April 15th, 'Tax day', normally comes and goes with little acknowledgement around our home, but this year was different. Kelley was meeting up with one of the girls who had joined our Friday group this semester. She had said on one occasion that she knew very little about Jesus. As they went through "The Four Spiritual Laws" Krissy was tracking and interacting at a very high level. She could easily explain why Jesus came and what he accomplished through His death and resurrection. She was eager to put her trust in Jesus and His death for her sins! After expressing her faith in Jesus, she looked at Kelley and said, "I feel so clean!" Amazing what God did on 'tax day'!

A few days later, Lazel met with Kelley and showed interest in the Gospel as well. She was not ready to trust in Christ yet, but now understands what it means to trust in Jesus! She had previously heard parts of the Gospel, bits and pieces. Lazel will soon return to her home country to an aunt and cousin who are believers.
