Romans 12:3-11

Last week we learned from Jesus that humility is where Christian servanthood begins.

Today we're going to see and set three goals for our lives as servants of Jesus and of each other.

Serving well in God's kingdom begins by not over-imagining your own contribution. You are just one part of the body. (v. 3-4)

Only if you are willing to serve on the team ("in the family") will you maximize your service for Christ. (v. 5)

Your skills and abilities are GIFTS from God, enabling you to play your part in His kingdom. (v. 6)

Giving the gifts is God's part, putting forth real effort to use them is yours.
