They will walk and not faint."



UPDATES FROM YOUR TRUSTEES

Last week, we received news from 101 Mobility that the new Savaria Elevator will be arriving in mid-September. We have informed J2Builders, who are reconstructing our shaft. 101 Mobility has also been in contact with them. In addition, we have been in contact with Bob Kelly at Maurer Electric to proceed with the electrical work needed for the elevator. They will also work with us in redoing the electric lighting in the Fellowship Hall, Kitchen, and the Pastor's office.

Work has been completed in the Community Food Pantry refurbishing the walls and the floor. A special grant was received from the Food Bank of Eastern Michigan for additional shelving. We are looking forward to more refrigeration for additional meat and perishables. It's been surprising that the usage of the Community Food Pantry has risen by over 100% since 2024. Thank you for all your gifts which help keep the shelves stocked!


NURTURE, OUTREACH, & WITNESS COMMITTEE


EAST WINDS DISTRICT CONFERENCE SAVE THE DATE
