<p>Here are some ways to focus on putting others first at home this month.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Post a sheet of paper with each family member's name on their bedroom door or on the refrigerator. Ask family members to write a compliment or a comment of thanks on other family members' sheet each week. • Start a complaint jar. Every time someone complains about something that is not really a big deal, put in a marble or rock. Pick a predetermined number and when you have that many in the jar, the family will agree to do a family service project such as clean a neighbors car, deliver cookies to a fire station, or send cards to a nursing home. 	<p>For August we will observe an annual ministry opportunity called Christmas in August.
