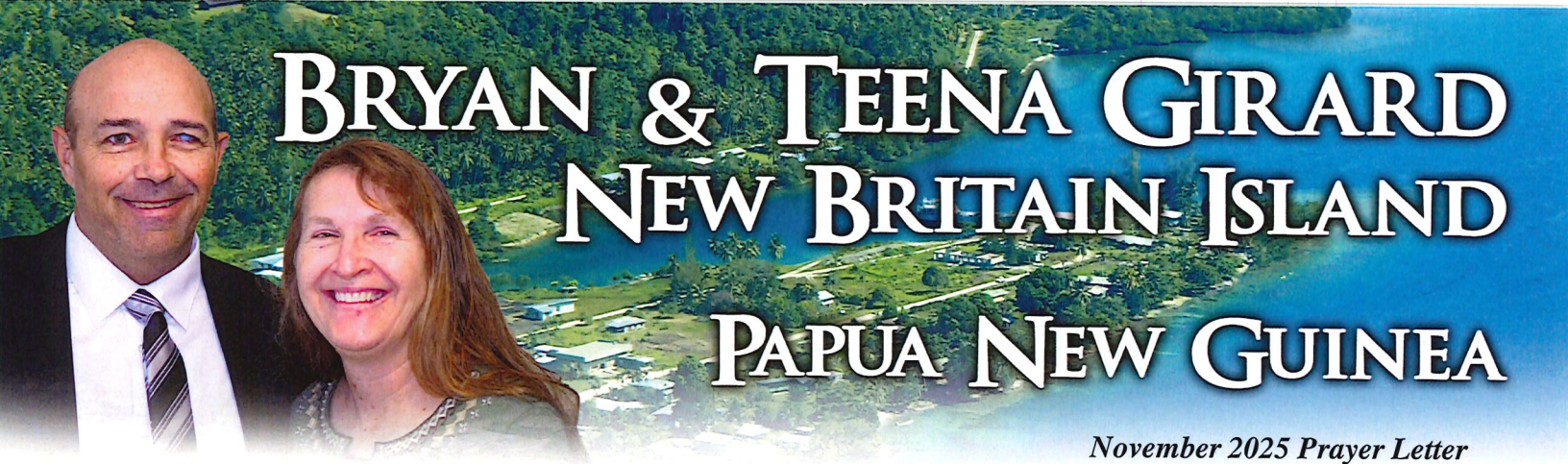




November 2025 Prayer Letter

Saturday begins the first of a series of work days for our January Camp Meeting at Anchor Baptist Church. We have a lot to do and we are a small group for the tasks ahead, so we ask for your prayers. Getting in and out of Kandrian is not an easy thing, so please pray about this as well.

The Eklep Friday Fellowship continues to grow. Our folks are inviting their family that live close by and some are starting to come and hear the word of God. A good number of our folks here in Kandrian pile on the truck and go as well. It is always a good time of fellowship and good preaching. The Lord is good. Eddie has been released from jail. I am not sure why, but praise the Lord anyway. I guess the other guys decided to settle out of court. He is thankful for all of the prayers; it has obviously made a difference.

We continue to plod on the King Jems Pisin Baibel second edition updates.

Please continue to pray for our workshop rebuild. The main thing we need to finish is the guest room in the back corner so we can use it for our meeting. Also pray for me to get my boat put back together so we can use it for helping of the transportation for our big meeting. Both of these are time-consuming projects and since the kids left, it all falls on me and Teena. Pray for stamina for these two old folks! We get worn out but are having the time of our lives.

Our crates have arrived to Singapore and will get on another ship and head for PNG. Since the original arrival date was incorrect, they were not able to get there in time to get on the Lae ship coming to Kandrian. This ship only comes every couple of months, so pray for the timing of its arrival. If it gets to Lae too early, I may face large storage fees, unless the shipper to Kandrian is merciful to me and just stores it for me. Clint in Indonesia has also sent another shipment of Bibles, Anchor Hymnals, and Map Books. He has included our newest project, the King Jems Pisin Baibel New Testament English and Tok Pisin side by side. He is also sending another printer for the printshop, another project we need to complete. It's expansion will probably be postponed until after the meeting.
