### Prison Ministry Report

The services in our local prisons and jails have gone extremely well over the past few weeks. We are thankful that things are back on schedule for 2026 and that we are consistently ministering in both the men's and ladies' facilities.

Recently, during one of our services in the ladies' unit, we had one of the best attendances we've seen in several months. During the invitation, several ladies came forward to receive Christ as their personal Savior. As we dealt with them individually, some needed assurance of their salvation, and we praise the Lord for three who were gloriously saved.

In the men's units, we also experienced great attendance. Several men rededicated their lives to serve the Lord, and one trusted Christ as his personal Savior. It is often considered taboo for a prisoner to pray in front of others, but this young man was broken and weeping profusely as he bowed his head and humbly accepted Christ into his heart.

### Church Services

Our travels have taken us from coast to coast, including meetings in Georgia, Tennessee, North Carolina, South Carolina, Wyoming, and California.

We have been able to report to some of our supporting churches that we had not been able to visit in recent years due to our busy schedule. We have also had the opportunity to be in several special meetings. We are truly grateful for every church that supports Peggy and me, allowing us to

serve as your hands and feet on the mission field. Without the local church, we would not be able to fulfill our calling.

We also praise the Lord for two children of former prisoners who were saved during one of our church services.

Additionally, during one of our meetings, a pastor's son, now married with children and serving the Lord, shared with me that he was saved under our ministry nearly three decades ago. It was a tremendous blessing and encouragement to be reminded of God's grace and faithfulness over the past 40 years of missionary service.
