We finished our meetings in California and headed east. We were able to spend a night in Phoenix with some friends, and then on to Texas. We stopped in to a new church (for us) just for the Wednesday night service, saw some old friends, and were well treated by all those we met there. We then travelled to Houston and were able to have lunch Sunday afternoon with Melanie Ellis, a former PNG missionary, after the morning service at Shady Acres.

In New Caney, TX, we had a meeting with our first supporting church, East River Baptist Church. We stayed in their prophet's chamber for a few days and had a great meeting on Sunday night. Teena and I had decided on some building projects we wanted to do when we returned, but that we would not mention it to anyone unless they asked. We had dinner with the assistant pastor, and he asked. In the Sunday night service the church decided to give us 3/5ths of what we needed. In a fellowship dinner after church, they informed us they had decided to give us the other 2/5ths as well. The Lord is so good to us.

We have been so blessed to see them and be in services where the Lord has moved and helped people. They have all been so good to us; exceeding abundantly above all we could ask or think.

We leave soon for our home church, Moriah Baptist in Fort Oglethorpe, GA, to spend some time there and in that area, including Word For The World's Candidate School, before heading off to North Carolina for another missions conference.
