story twice today."

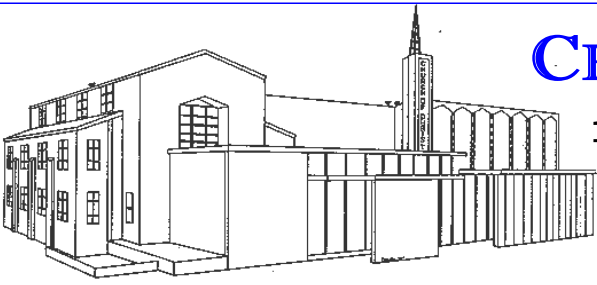
Blessed are they who know the way to bring back

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Three Reasons Why the Law Could Not Save?

The churches of Galatia were taught by the apostle, Paul, during his first missionary journey. Sometime after this around 54 AD, Judaizers' were under-minding the work of Paul, by teaching those Christians from Galatia that they needed to go back to the Law of Moses for their salvation! The Letter to the Galatians is written with this background. Paul will write six chapters by defending the faith of the Gospel in Christ Jesus; and not that of the Law. Galatians chapter three Paul discusses how the Law could not save! Let us consider this thought!

The Law Condemns the Guilty at the First Infraction:

"For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, 'Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them'" (Galatians 3:10). Paul in quoting from Deuteronomy 27:26, to show how those Jews under the Old Law had to obey all of the Law. If, they were disobedient to part of the law, they were guilty of all the Law.

The Law Cannot Justify the Sinner:

"Now it is evident that no one is justified before God by the law, for The righteous shall live by faith" (Galatians 3:11). Paul once again, quotes from the Old Testament to show that it is by Faith that man is justified. He quotes from Habakkuk 2:4! This is how man has always been and will be saved. The Faithful of the Old Testament were saved by God's Grace/Favor and they responded to it by Faith!

The Law Requires Sinless Observance:

"But the law is not of faith, rather 'The one who does them shall live by them'" (Galatians 3:12). This verse, reaffirms the principle taught in Galatians 3:10. Paul again, quotes from the Old Testament, Leviticus 18:5, to point out the fallacy of the Old Law saving man. Paul will continue to show that the law was fulfilled in Christ Jesus (Galatians 3:13,14). More to Come Next Week!
