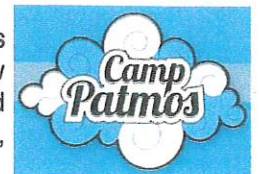

While there, our video projector which has served us for 11 years of conferences and a semester of teaching Bible, finally showed us that it needed replaced. When the pastor called to share this news, he also shared that he'd had nothing but positive responses about the teaching.
