

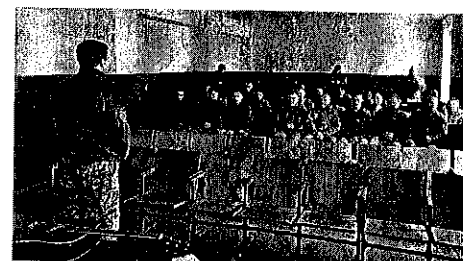


MARCH 2021

My Dear Praying Friends,

The spring is finally here so it is usually the busiest time of the year in our Jewish ministry. We have many nonstop guests and evangelistic events scheduled for the next three months with Dr. Henry Benach (and his wife Victoria) joining us March, 26 – April, 15. Bro. Henry's visit coincides with the Jewish Feast of Passover (starting on Sabbath Day of Saturday, March 26th and going through the whole next week) commonly celebrated by all Jewish communities around the world. We will conduct the 11th annual "Prophecy and Israel" Conference in the city of Kremenchug (central Ukraine) and hold an "Honor Israel" Banquet in Dnipro, a Women's Conference "You are Called", participate in a large Ukrainian Mission Conference, preach in six different Baptist churches and mid-week services, street ministry, visiting Jewish neighborhoods and businesses with gospel tracts, attending the synagogue, etc. We are praying those will be actions and events packed three weeks bearing much fruit. **Please, pray with us no Covid restrictions will hinder us, for the safety in all the travels and Bro. Henry's and my health. Thank you!**

A lot of time in March was spent preparing everything for the above-mentioned outreaches. We were denied by many restaurants to hold an "Honor Israel" Banquet there. Having a hard time arranging for the simplest things we had no problem before like printing conference materials, pens and misc. stuff, hiring the buses for transporting the people, buying books and renting spacious facilities for the outreaches. A lot of it shifted online and so more time is spent behind the computer screen instead of personal contact and involvement (soon perhaps we will be leading people to Christ on Zoom instead of one-on-one. I hope not). Of course, considering everything being shut down in 2020 we are happy for the comparative liberty to do ministry in 2021 and so we intend to take a full advantage of it **with your prayers for being able to move and act freely within the made plans.**



One of such in-person events we had this month was a trip to the military zone with our good friend from USA Bro. Ron Jackson (Cleveland Baptist Church, Cleveland, OH) and a small group he brings when he comes. We traveled to the southern border to the city of Mariupol where we visited different military bases and a hospital and held evangelistic meetings every time with singing, preaching and distributing humanitarian aid to all present. **Praise the Lord during the three days of our travels and speaking to the soldiers we had 14 decisions for salvation** (indicated by the raised hands, including the medical personnel and officers) to several of whom we were able to speak personally and instruct them in the newfound faith, leaving much literature behind with them.
