My Dear Praying Friends,

Both months, September and October, turned to be warm with minimum rains – just a beautiful Indian Summer. That prolonged our time out in the streets with gospel tracts and a personal witness despite the people being dubious to speak to you or take anything from you. Street ministry still remains one of my favourite parts of the overall work as the authorities may prohibit you from holding any meetings but you can still go one-on-one with sinners out in the open (even on crutches, hehe). Thousands of tracts distributed and dozens of solid witnessing conversations resulting in some folks visiting the services of Menorah Baptist Church and just this past Sunday I led Alena to the Lord after the morning service (seen in the picture). What a blessing it is to see people still getting saved, Amen! We've been having good turn outs at the church with three new members added recently by letter (in addition to the three new ones baptized in August) and two new prospects in the works. However, still can't have more than 30 in our regular attendance. **Please, pray for Menorah Baptist Church and its ministry.**



Our city (as well as the whole state and three neighbouring states) just entered a "red zone" quarantine lockdown. This one is the worst of them yet as the authorities push the vaccination on people and one can't really travel, even get on the city public transportation, enter most stores and establishments without the vaccination passport of a PCR-test (it's not about masks any more). Yet again, everything is closed and churches are officially prohibited from having services. They won't even let us into the building let alone have a service. I had to call the police to help us get into the building and fear now the administration will call the police on us next time to prevent us from entering at all, it's becoming that bad. We may be forced to go online until the craziness is over, if it will ever be over, but we aim to keep the church doors open like every other quarantine lockdown in the past year. **It is a pressing prayer need for our physical ministry to go on as the governmental screws are tightened like never before.**

Back in September we had Dr. Henry Benach and Pastor Greg Powell (with their wives) assist us in the work here with multiple events in multiple cities. We held three "Prophecy and Israel" Conferences in three cities in three days, "You Are Called" Ladies' Conference, taught in a Bible Seminary and preached in five churches in three cities. The attendance wasn't as high as we anticipated but still hundreds of people attended and I believe we accomplished what we set out to do. (Really proud of the ladies, Olga, Victoria and Karen, to have held such a wonderful ladies' conference). 
