Guidelines and Goals:

- 1. **Remember:** All of this is about serving the Lord. That's what we want the ladies to see in us when we are serving at this special occasion.
- 2. Cleanliness and Germ Control. Every server must wash their hands before handling plates, glasses, utensils, or cups. Avoid touching your nose, mouth, and eyes while serving. No one should plate or serve food if they have symptoms or diagnosis of an illness (such as vomiting, diarrhea or fever) within the past 6 hours.
- 3. Clean Up. Once the banquet has ended, we ask that all volunteers help clear tables. If everyone helps, this usually takes about 30 minutes, and is normally completed around 8:30 pm depending on when the banquet ends.

It is customary to serve and remove **plates** from the left side of the person dinning.

It is customary to fill **glasses** and coffee cups from the right.
