FUN WAYS TO HELP YOUR FAMILY LIVE OUT THEIR WORSHIP THIS SUMMER

WAYS TO WORSHIP

- Talk with your children about how worship isn't music - worship is us adoring God and giving Him glory in our lives. So many of our day-to-day routines can be worship when we do it for God's glory. Talk with your children about what things they're doing that day (chores, hanging out with friends, serving, etc.) that they can do as an offering to the Lord.
- Ask you children to write down 3 things that stir their love & awe of Jesus. What makes them say, "WOW, God!" Perhaps it's a sunset, or a good ice cream bar, or being out in nature. What makes them stand in awe of God?
- Talk with your children about how they can take little moments to say, "Thanks, God!" when they're having a fun time this summer. All good gifts come from our Father, so how can we develop a heart of gratitude for all the wonderful things we enjoy?

QUESTION BOX

It's never too early to get our kids thinking about the big questions of their faith. Fill a wooden box with cards that have challenging questions, such as "How do we know God exists?" "Is Jesus really God's Son?" and "Are all religions equally true?" Several cards can have answers on the back, while others can be more open-ended, requiring kids to think and discuss the topic.

SERVE YOUR NEIGHBOR

- Is there someone who could use assistance mowing their lawn or cleaning up their yard? Gather your family (and maybe a few neighbors!) to make it happen!
- Take time to talk about the important people in your children's lives and be sure to express that gratitude. Consider grandparents, aunts and uncles, cousins, classmates, teachers, friends, mentors, pastors, and neighbors. Write a thank you note (or email) to each person. Kids can choose a Bible verse that expresses thanks or encouragement for each person.
- Choose a morning or afternoon to serve at a local ministry, such as Hands of Jesus, Hope House, God's Food Bank or any ministry of your choosing! Reflect with you children afterward: What was it like to serve instead of being served? How can we have this Christ-like attitude daily?

PRAYER WALK

Take a stroll in nature, appreciate God's handiwork, and bask in the beauty of nature. Talk with your kids about God's limitless power and His attention to details, and what that means for our lives.

BIBLE CAMP

Hosting a Neighborhood Bible Camp provides a perfect opportunity for children to learn more about the gospel while creating community, building relationships with friends, and maybe making new friends. While playing games and creating crafts, they learn more about Jesus' love for them while possibly learning new skills.
