

Job Description For Worship Assistants

Purpose:

- To participate in worship with the pastor(s)
- To read Scripture
- To lead liturgical readings
- To pray
- To lead the children's sermon
- Sign-up for a time that suits your schedule

Training: It will be important to participate in periodic training sessions as together we grow in our understanding of worship and worship leadership.

Scripture: To bring the Scripture reading to life through inflective reading. To have a sense of the passages' meaning and how it relates to the worship theme for the day.

Liturgical Readings: Occasionally there will be responsive readings that you will lead, again using inflective reading.

Pray: Lead the congregation in prayer. You can write your own prayers or use prayers that you find meaningful. It is important to connect the prayer to the worship theme for the day. If you are leading the pastoral prayer, it is important to pray for people in the congregation and relevant local and global issues.

Children's Sermon: Creatively engage the young people in a conversation related to the Scripture passages and worship themes of the day. End your time together with prayer.
